The Westminster Memorial Scrolls Trust

During World War II, the Nazis confiscated all the Jewish ritual items and sacred Torah Scrolls from Jewish communities of Bohemia and Moravia, then known as Czechoslovakia. It was believed that Hitler's plan was to use these objects of Judaica to create a museum of an extinct race – the Jews. This collection of Jewish cultural and religious artifacts bears witness to the Holocaust. Today, these Czech Torahs, part of this precious legacy, are being used in congregations throughout the world as a source of Jewish spiritual continuity.

In 1964, the Westminster Synagogue in London, England, agreed to receive 1,564 Torah Scrolls from Prague. Most were significantly damaged. They established the Memorial Trust to restore the scrolls and distribute them to communities throughout the world.

Torah Restoration at Calvary

The Westminster Memorial Scrolls Trust entrusted Scroll No. 515, from the town of Taus-Domazlice, dating from 1880, to Calvary Hospital. We are honored to be home to this sacred Scroll, and to be one of more than 1,400 sites throughout the world to have these scrolls on permanent loan.

As custodian of Scroll No. 515, it is Calvary's responsibility to safeguard it. In January 2014, the Hospital enlisted an expert Torah scribe to thoroughly examine every column (*yeriah*) of our Torah. It was determined that while there is significant damage to this scroll, it would be possible to

repair it. Calvary is embarking on a year-long restoration project to return this Torah back to *kosher* status, so that it may once again be used in Jewish rituals and religious services.
