Message from the Chairman of the Board and President

Since our hospital was founded nearly 120 years ago, Calvary has been an international leader on many fronts. Whether it's for the excellence of our palliative care, our extensive experience in end-of-life care, teaching thousands of physicians and nurses from across the globe, taking our care into the community, partnering with families, or our comprehensive bereavement support program, Calvary has been leading the way.

It all starts with our outstanding team. We don't simply hire employees with top-notch clinical skills. They also must have the passion to care for patients in the last weeks, days, and sometimes just hours, of their lives.

At Calvary, visitors are welcome at any time. That means that any person we hire has to be committed to caring for families 24/7 with the same love and compassion that they provide to patients. That's a tall order. But we know our staff is more than up to the task. In fact, for 12 consecutive years, Press Ganey has ranked Calvary in the top percentiles of patient satisfaction of the more than 7,000 hospitals that they rate each year.

Our team's commitment to patients and families is essential to delivering *CalvaryCare*SM at our four inpatient facilities or in hundreds of home settings. Whether patients have advanced cancer or other life-limiting illnesses, we want to ensure that the last moments of life for our patients are what they and their families envision as the best possible quality of life.

We are proud of several key milestones in 2017:

- We cared for 5,668 patients and families. This includes 2,653 inpatients and 3,015 hospice and home care patients;
- In the past three years, The Dawn Greene Hospice has cared for more than 700 patients;
- In just one year, Ozanam Hall of Queens Nursing Home has cared for 300 patients;
- Our 14th Annual Attorney Conference drew a record number of attendees – 325;
- We marked 20 years of Calvary's Camp Compass[®], our summer camp for grieving children and teenagers;
- Calvary Fund raised approximately \$8.2 million for our programs and services, including nearly \$1 million alone at our Annual Awards Gala in November; and

Leading the Way in the Inpatient Experience

Calvary cares for patients at our 200-bed facility in the Bronx and our 25-bed Brooklyn Campus in Sunset Park. Under the supervision of Calvary@Home, we also provide short-term inpatient care at the 10-bed Dawn Greene Hospice located at Mary Manning Walsh Home in Manhattan and at Ozanam Hall of Queens Nursing Home in Bayside.

The difference in the inpatient experience starts from the very beginning. As soon as our patients arrive, our goal is to get them admitted to their rooms *within 15 minutes*. We help them get settled and comfortable. With few exceptions, our patients are housed in private rooms with shared bathrooms. Telephone and TV service are provided at no charge.

Within the first few hours, our patients meet their team of caregivers who will remain with them during their entire stay. The team includes the doctor, nurse, Calvary Care Technician (CCT), family care practitioner (social worker), spiritual care provider and dietitian.

The Nursing Team

Our nursing department, comprised of registered nurses, nurse practitioners and Calvary Care Technicians, is an important reason why Calvary is world-renowned for its patient care. CCTs are specially trained and educated to maximize the patient care experience. Whether they have spent their entire career at Calvary or came to us after working at other hospitals, our nursing department wants to be here caring for our patients.

Nutrition

Patients select their meals from a daily menu. If requested, the Nutritional Services department is happy to accommodate special requests at no extra charge.

We realize how important food memories can be for our patients, since the dishes may evoke happy and pleasant memories from a time of well-being.

The Personal Touch

We encourage family members to decorate patients' rooms with personal mementos that are meaningful and soothing to their loved ones. When we discover ways to make our patients feel more at home, such as a favorite dessert, music, or religious custom, we often take the initiative to make these things a part of the patients' stay with us.

Unlike other hospitals, we encourage visitors at any time – human as well as pets. People who wish to stay overnight may do so in the patient's room or in several rooms on the premises – at no charge. We understand that when a loved one is near the end of life, making it easy for family and friends to visit and be present is a simple yet important accommodation to offer.

The Brooklyn Campus

Since opening in 2001, Calvary's 25-bed Brooklyn campus has cared for more than 5,500 inpatients and their families. In addition to inpatient care, Calvary provides home care and hospice care to patients throughout this vibrant borough, and offers adults, children and teenagers weekly bereavement support groups that take place in downtown Brooklyn.

Leading the Way in the Home

Calvary@Home provides our comprehensive home care and hospice services to patients at home who are suffering from advanced cancer or other chronic and acute terminal illnesses and who live in the metropolitan New York area.

- Home healthcare is available in all five boroughs as well as Westchester, Rockland and Nassau counties; hospice services in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Queens, and Manhattan, and Nassau, Westchester and Rockland counties.
- Calvary collaborates with more than 25 nursing homes in Brooklyn, Manhattan, the Bronx and Westchester, Rockland, and Nassau counties, to provide hospice care to their residents.

- At The Dawn Greene Hospice (TDGH), under the supervision of Calvary@Home, the Hospital provides short-term inpatient care for Manhattan residents. To date, TDGH has cared for more than 700 patients at this 10-bed facility.
- We established a new partnership with Ozanam Hall in Queens and now offer an inpatient level of hospice care there. In just over a year, Calvary has already cared for more than 300 patients at this location.

Wherever we care for a Calvary@Home patient, the quality of care is the same top standard for which we are known across the country and around the globe.

Leading the Way in Family Care

Social workers play an integral role in the lives of our patients and their families. To reflect this, Calvary renamed this department *Family Care*, and its caregivers are known as *Family Care Practitioners*.

The Family Care Practitioner helps to identify what support the family needs and ensures they get it. This is the person family members are encouraged to contact whenever any issue arises. Every member of this department has a Master's degree in Social Work and advanced end-of-life training. They choose to be here, working with people in one of the most intimate and difficult times in the life of any family.

For more than a decade, Calvary's *Family Care Center* (FCC) at the Bronx Campus has served thousands of adults and children. It offers a respite from the emotional intensity of the patient units, the opportunity to speak with the FCC coordinator, check email, read a newspaper, get a manicure or a cup of coffee, or simply relax near the salt-water fish tank and gather their thoughts.

No other hospital puts as much time and effort into caring for the family as Calvary.

Leading the Way in Spiritual Care

Spiritual pain takes on great significance when people are facing the end of their lives for themselves or their loved ones. That is why Calvary, unlike most hospitals, employs 30 full-time chaplains. They are available seven days a week to attend to the spiritual needs of our inpatients as well as for our patients being cared for in their homes.

Chaplains lead worship services regularly at our multi-faith chapel in the Bronx, visit with patients at the Brooklyn Campus, provide individual counseling, and host Memorial Services regularly for the Christian and Jewish community. They also perform sacraments and other religious rituals. Upon request, a Spanish-speaking member of the ministry is available.

The Jewish Community

- Jewish patients and families can look forward to amenities such as: kosher food, a daily visit from one of three rabbis, a well-stocked Kosher Hospitality Room, dedicated Shabbos Lounge, Kabbalat Shabbat service, and celebrations of all major holidays.
- Since 2012, Calvary has partnered with leading Jewish organizations to educate people about how to obtain excellent end-of-life care in full accordance with Jewish law (*Halakha*).

Our success at educating and caring for the Jewish community has been recognized multiple times by the New York City chapter of the Public Relations Society of America, the largest in the country.

For chaplains interested in professional education, Calvary offers an accredited 20-week, 400-hour Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) program, the country's only one that provides students with hands-on experience with terminally ill patients. In a few short years, Calvary's CPE program has become one of the most diverse in the country.

We host an annual Spiritual Care Day to provide the interfaith community in the greater New York area with the opportunity to learn from each other in their sacred work as chaplains.

Leading the Way in Bereavement Support

Calvary's comprehensive bereavement support program includes two dozen groups for adults, children and teens that meet regularly in the Bronx, downtown Brooklyn, and Manhattan.

We know that in order to facilitate the healing process, it helps people to find common ground in their grief. That's why – unlike most bereavement support groups – Calvary's adult groups are organized by one's relationship to the deceased. So young bereaved spouses/partners, 60+ bereaved spouses/partners, adult children, parents of adult children, siblings, etc. meet with people just like them.

The Hospital's program includes groups for young adults (ages 18-25), men only, and one conducted entirely in Spanish.

Our children's bereavement program includes:

- Precious Moments groups for school-age children ages 6-9;
- Tween group for children ages 10-12;
- Teen groups for children ages 13-17; and
- Calvary's Camp Compass®, a week-long summer day camp for grieving children and teens that takes place at Kingsborough Community College in Brooklyn.

A connection to Calvary is not necessary for people to participate in any of our free bereavement support groups or the summer camp.

The Hospital shares its expertise with an annual 10-week bereavement course for people in the helping professions, featuring various Calvary experts, and a four-week "Mentors through Mourning" program for school guidance counselors, teachers, and school administrators. These courses take place at the Hospital's Bronx campus and at a convenient location in downtown Brooklyn.



Leading the Way Across the Globe

The Hospital established the Palliative Care Institute (PCI) 32 years ago to educate healthcare professionals about Calvary's unique family-centric approach to patient care. Since then, we have welcomed thousands of physicians, nurses, social workers and other healthcare professionals from dozens of countries. They study with us from two weeks to six months or more.

In 2005, the National Institutes of Health's National Cancer Institute designated Calvary "an international leader in palliative care" and invited us to participate in the Middle East Cancer Consortium (MECC). Comprised of the national ministries of health from Egypt, Turkey, Israel, Cyprus, Jordan, and the Palestinian Authority, MECC members have visited Calvary regularly over the past decade.

The goal of our PCI visitors can be as simple as improving the end-of-life experience for their patients to establishing their country's first master's level program in palliative care nursing.

Al-Sadeel, in Bethlehem, is the first organization to offer palliative services to dying patients in Palestine. It was founded by husband and wife nurses, Amal Dweib-Khleif and Mohamad Khleif, as a direct result of their training at Calvary.

Annual visitors to the PCI include healthcare professionals from coast-to-coast as well as 800 students from every medical school in the greater New York area. The students, who come here for visits ranging from one day to semester-long weekly visits, include EMT members training to become paramedics for the Fire Department of the City of New York.

Leading the Way in Therapeutic Recreation

Every day a hospital activity is planned for inpatients such as ceramics, flower arranging, bingo, or music. We also coordinate monthly visits by Juilliard students, monthly patient birthday parties, and holiday barbecues on the hospital terrace.

For many patients, these activities may help them regain a sense of normalcy and a reminder of what their lives used to be like before their illness progressed. We know that whatever activities they choose to attend, our patients get a great deal of joy and comfort from therapeutic recreation.

At Calvary, we consider it our duty to help our patients enjoy their time through the end of life. This is why Calvary truly is the place *"where life continues."*

Volunteers

Calvary's reputation for the best end-of-life care would not be possible without the hundreds of dedicated people who volunteer regularly for us. Volunteers at the Bronx or Brooklyn campuses often transport patients, assist at mealtime, sit with anxious patients, and help with bereavement calls to family and friends.

Volunteers with Calvary@Home can often be found providing companionship to our patients and offering a respite to their caregivers.

Many volunteers are fluent in several languages or have knowledge of different cultural practices. These skills are a huge plus for a place like Calvary that accepts patients of every religious and ethnic background.

The Corcillo Family

The Corcillo family, devout Catholics, have supported the Calvary mission for decades. Patriarch Al Corcillo was a founding member of the Mary Queen of Peace Council #4521 of the Knights of Columbus in the early 1960s. Under Al's leadership and watchful eye, this chapter has raised more than \$1.2 million for Calvary. Al passed away at our Bronx campus in 2012, and his beloved wife, Marion, died at Calvary in 2017. Message from the Executive Medical Director

Each year, we focus the Annual Report on a theme that captures the essence of the Calvary mission of caring for patients at the end of life. This year's theme of *"leading the way"* is about as perfect a theme as we have ever had and has special significance to me.

The Brescia-Cimino Fistula

Before I started working at Calvary in 1963, I was a physician with a national reputation as a nephrologist. It was my dedication to the treatment of patients suffering from kidney disease that motivated me and Dr. James Cimino to collaborate. Several years later in 1966, we co-invented the *Brescia-Cimino Fistula*.

Before we invented this remarkable product, the only way to access the blood of people undergoing dialysis was something called a Scribner shunt. While this did the job, and allowed blood flow to reduce clotting, it lasted only a few days to weeks.

Dr. Cimino and I agreed that there had to be a better way and we immediately started working together. The result was the Brescia-Cimino Fistula. Scribner shunts were quickly replaced with our fistulas. Today, 42 years later, our invention remains the most effective, longest-lasting method for long-term access to patients' blood for hemodialysis.

During my 55-year tenure at Calvary, we have been leading the way in many ways.

The International Healthcare Community

The Palliative Care Institute was started in 1985. Since then, we have earned National Institutes of Health's recognition as an international leader in palliative care. In addition to the many local medical students and physicians we help educate, Calvary has taught our family-centric patient care model to healthcare professionals from more than 30 countries to date, including Japan, Korea, Nepal and India to Oman, Iraq, Spain and Peru.

We are especially proud of our participation in the Middle East Cancer Consortium (MECC). Comprised of the national ministries of health from Egypt, Turkey, Israel, Cyprus, Jordan, and the Palestinian Authority, MECC members have visited Calvary regularly over the past decade. As one former PCI visitor told us, "We have the Calvary DNA right here in our country!"



Halakhic End-of-Life Care

Since our earliest days, Calvary has embraced patients from a diversity of faiths and religious backgrounds. Jewish patients have a long history with us, yet many people are unaware of this.

Five years ago, we consolidated the program of care we offer Jewish patients and made a concerted effort to educate the entire community about Calvary. We addressed the concerns and misconceptions some people had about whether hospice care could be adequately provided under *Halakha* (Jewish law). We succeeded beyond our wildest dreams.

Today, members of even the most observant Jewish communities all feel very comfortable entrusting their own – and their care of loved ones – to our incredible staff.

A few years ago, we also restored a sacred 135-year-old Torah scroll. Our fundraising efforts doubled the amount of funds that we needed to complete this project. Once the restoration was paid for, we used the rest of the funds raised to benefit all Calvary patients.

We are so proud that our initiatives for the Jewish community have garnered three prestigious awards from the Public Relations Society of America's New York chapter, the country's largest.

Calvary has been leading the way since 1899. May God bless our mission and everyone on our staff. With your continued generous support, we will continue *leading the way* for many years to come.

The Calvary Fund Report

2017: An Overview of Our Fund-Raising Year

In 2017, the Calvary Fund raised nearly \$8.2 million in gifts and new pledges, to support and advance the mission of Calvary Hospital.

Carlos M. Hernandez, the Chairman of the Calvary Fund, oversaw a successful 2017 Awards Gala, which raised nearly \$1 million. Adam Tan, CEO of the HNA Group, was awarded the Calvary Medal at the Gala. In expressing his gratitude to Calvary for the honor, Mr. Tan quoted Calvary's Executive Medical Director, Michael J. Brescia, MD, who "taught" him the secret of *CalvaryCare*SM – to touch our patients, hold them, and tell them we love them. "These things are so simple," Mr. Tan says. "They are what we all – what the whole world – needs."

For the second year in a row, several Calvary Fund Directors, who wish to remain anonymous, made a challenge grant to match all gifts during the month of December, and our friends stepped up to the plate to match it. We raised a total of \$282,918, bringing the value of the challenge to \$392,918. Thanks to the hundreds of Calvary supporters who were inspired by this challenge grant to give generously.

The ten beds at The Dawn Greene Hospice, Calvary's inpatient hospice located on the 15th floor of Mary Manning Walsh Home in Manhattan, have been in demand since the facility opened in October, 2014. We are grateful to the Jerome L. Greene Foundation, whose grant of \$4 million funded construction and equipment of this beautiful facility. Now, Calvary has reached an agreement with Mary Manning Walsh Home to expand The Dawn Greene Hospice from its current capacity to a total of 18 private rooms. Christina McInerney, President of the Jerome L. Greene Foundation – and Mrs. Greene's daughter – has pledged the Foundation's support for this expansion, which is expected to be completed in spring, 2018.

Our good friend, Joe Cairo, renewed his support for Calvary Hospital with a gift of \$150,000 from the Pat Cairo Family Foundation, created to honor his wife, whose care at Calvary meant so much to him and their four children. Joe asked us to direct a portion of this grant to training for our nurses because of the outstanding nursing care Pat received at Calvary.

Calvary's 25-bed Brooklyn campus opened in October 2001, just a few weeks after the World Trade Center attacks, when the city and nation were in shock and mourning. Bridges throughout the metro area were virtually shut down, making travel difficult. Establishing our care in Brooklyn at this challenging moment affirmed Calvary's strong commitment to serving Brooklyn residents.

Today, Calvary cares for hundreds of Brooklyn patients and families every year, at the Brooklyn campus and through our home health agency and home hospice. Brooklyn's Circle of Hope Cancer Foundation was among the first groups to recognize the importance of our care for New York's most populous borough. Since 2006, Circle of Hope has raised more than \$120,000 for our Brooklyn care. In 2017, the Brooklyn Friends of Calvary, an advocacy group made up of individuals whose family members have been cared for by Calvary, became more active than ever in promoting our Brooklyn care and helping their friends and neighbors access our care. People from across the New York area and well beyond contributed to a successful year for Calvary's direct mail program. Direct mail, an important part of our overall external relations activities, raised \$1,530,682 from 23,471 donors.

Our leadership donor group, the Storrs Society, recognizes everyone who has given a cumulative total of \$1,000 in fiscal year 2017 (January 1 – December 31). The Storrs Society, named for Calvary's esteemed founder, Annie Blount Storrs, now has more than 850 members.

Calvary's Professional Advisors Council

Our Professional Advisors Council (PAC) was established in 2001 to assist the Board of Directors and staff in securing the financial support needed to sustain *CalvaryCare*SM. PAC members are volunteers from the legal, investment, accounting, insurance, and banking professions. Michael J. A. Smith is Chairman of the PAC and also a Director of the Calvary Fund.

The bequests we receive every year enable us to maintain the high standards that define *CalvaryCare*. In 2017, we received a total of \$3,204,469 from 51 estates. Bequests reflect the foresight and thoughtfulness of numerous patients, families, and friends. It is a credit to the hard work of our PAC members (see list, page 28), who help us identify individuals for whom Calvary is the right place for them to leave a legacy.

Description of Organization

Organization

Calvary Holding Company, Inc. (the "Company") is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Section 402 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York. The Company is exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3). The purpose of the Company is to engage in charitable, scientific and medical activities to support the Calvary Hospital, Inc. (the "Hospital") and its affiliated organizations which are exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. ArchCare, a not-for-profit corporation, is the sole corporate member of the Company and the Hospital.

Principles of Combination

The combined financial statements include the accounts of the following organizations of which the Company is the sole corporate member:

- Calvary Fund, Inc. (the "Fund") is a not-for-profit corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Fund's purpose is to solicit, accept, and receive real and personal property and to collect income therefrom to be applied exclusively for any health-related charitable organization or corporation affiliated with the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of New York. However, the current and historical intent has been to provide exclusive support to the Hospital.
- Calvary Palliative Care Network, L.L.C. (the "Network") is a limited liability company that advises, consults, as well as provides administrative and management services to physicians, including professional groups and independent practice associations, hospitals, and other healthcare providers. The Network is the sole member of Calvary Network Independent Practice Association, L.L.C., an inactive entity. The Network became inactive effective January 1, 2001.

In addition, primarily because it is under common management with the above organizations, the Hospital is included in the combined financial statements. The Hospital is a not-for-profit specialty hospital that provides services for the care of adult patients with advanced cancer and other life-limiting illnesses. The Hospital, which is operated in connection with the Archdiocese of New York, is exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Intercompany transactions and amounts have been eliminated.
